CAST AGREEMENT

By submitting the registration form, I acknowledge that lack of attendance or repeated disruptive behavior is sufficient grounds for LSA to revoke my or my minor child's privilege of participation in LSA's Nutcracker on Ice. LSA will not refund any registration or costume fees in the event my or my minor child's privilege to participate in this program is revoked. I agree that absences will only be excused at the sole discretion of the Artistic Directors. Excused absences include academic testing (such as high school placement, SAT or ACT, or similar tests), another skating event, and family emergencies. Any absences must be approved by the Artistic Directors in advance. If I or my child are ill or injured, I/we will make every effort to be present to watch rehearsal and/or to catch up on any choreography my group's coach deems necessary

VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

By submitting the registration form, I acknowledge that I, or at least one member of my family, am expected to volunteer for at least two performances and to help serve on necessary committee(s). I recognize that my active participation is very important to the success and future of the show and of LSA and that I may be unable to watch the performance(s) that I work. I also understand that my refusal to volunteer is grounds for my or my child's dismissal from the cast and that no refund will be issued. I AGREE THAT I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, HAVE HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO ASK ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT IT THAT I MAY HAVE, AND THAT CHECKING THE BOX ON THE REGISTRATION FORM INDICATES MY AGREEMENT TO ALL OF ITS TERMS.

Nutcracker on Ice 2024 Soloist Agreement

Parents, committee chairs, and coaches work very hard to organize, promote, and produce Nutcracker on Ice, and all skaters work very hard rehearsing choreography. It is our job as club representatives not only to provide this opportunity for the skaters to perform and create good memories, but also to help them understand that, while being in the production (particularly as a soloist) is an honor, it is also a privilege, and with that privilege come particular leadership responsibilities and small sacrifices. To this end, the Artistic Directors and committee chairs expect the soloists to assist with several critical activities. Those activities include the following:

- □ All soloists must sign up [via Sign-up genius] for a time to appear in costume to promote the production during LTS class times. Soloist must also agree to appear in other promotions as needed (ex: Paristown pop-up performance). More information about these events will be forthcoming.
- □ All soloists must submit a 4x6 color photo to Katie Shipley no later than November 18th, for the NOI display window in the Iceland lobby.
- □ All soloists must also submit a digital photograph, and a brief bio to Ravnn, ravnn@me.com, no later than November 14th at 8:00 PM for the program. An example of a bio can be found on the NOI website. www.nutcrackeronice.com.
- □ All soloists must stay after the last performance is over to help take down all parts of the scenery and decorations. This is a labor-intensive task with jobs available for everyone. The only way it can be done quickly is if everyone participates.

Finally, all soloists are expected to serve as good role models for LSA's younger and less experienced members and to observe LSA's code of conduct for NOI. The soloists are the leaders of our production, and younger and less experienced cast members will look to them for guidance on how to act. In addition, as people are paying to see the performances, it is important for the soloists to behave in a professional and responsible manner. For performances and dress rehearsals, the code of conduct includes:

- □ Arriving on time with equipment and costume pieces, as required;
- □ Eating well before rehearsals and performances and staying hydrated;
- □ Following instructions from coaches, runners, room chaperones, and costume chairs; and
- □ Behaving respectfully and attentively before, during and after all rehearsals and performances.

Soloists who refuse to participate in these activities or who fail to abide by the code of conduct may be asked not to participate in future Nutcrackers on Ice.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge that I or my minor child am/is required to meet the above requirements and will make every effort to do so.
