



The Coolest Camp in Town - Overview

The Coolest Camp in Town is a recreational summer skating program for beginner level ice skaters ages 3 through 13. This camp is appropriate for children who are interested in acquiring fundamental skills for recreational skating, figure skating and/or hockey. No previous skating experience is necessary. Skaters meet daily, Monday through Friday, for on-ice and off-ice instruction and fun. Camp is located at Iceland Sports Complex, 1701 UPS Drive.

For 2010, *The Coolest Camp* will meet Monday through Friday, July 19-23rd and July 26-30th. Skaters may elect to attend either week or both weeks. Camp will meet daily from 1:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m.

The Coolest Camp in Town is run by Louisville Skating Academy, a non-profit organization dedicated to figure skaters in the Louisville area. Throughout the year, Louisville Skating Academy offers learn-to-skate classes for skaters of all ages and all levels. Classes follow the guidelines set forth by the United States Figure Skating Association's nationally recognized *Skate with U.S.* program.

LSA has a high-quality team of instructors and is recognized as an "Excellence on Ice" training facility by the Professional Skaters Association.

Camp Curriculum

The Coolest Camp in Town is focused on the FUN and FUNDAMENTALS of ice skating. Skaters are divided into classes based on age, experience and skill level. No prior skating experience is necessary to enroll.

Classes will follow the United States Figure Skating Association's *Skate With U.S.* program. Skaters who have not taken lessons previously will start in either "Tots" for those ages 3 through 5 or "Basic 1" for those ages 6 through 13. Skills will include forward skating, backward skating, stops, glides, curves, turns, hops, etc.

Skaters with lesson experience will be placed in the appropriate level from Basic 1 through Free Skate 2. Skaters above this level may want to inquire about LSA's summer training camp for competitive level skaters.

Camp Highlights

Highlights are as follows:

- More than 2 hours of ice time with a minimum of 45 minutes of on-ice instruction per day
- Off-ice activities and supervised recreation
- Snack break – snacks included
- Free skate rental
- Certificates awarded upon completion of levels
- Free camp T-shirt and photo
