Overview:

The **LSA Fall Celebration 2020** is a figure skating exhibition, open to the public on a limited basis and live streamed for all to enjoy! LSA is excited to provide an opportunity for skaters to perform and showcase their accomplishments.

The LSA Fall Celebration 2020 is open to Louisville Skating Academy skaters of all ages and levels, as well as skaters from neighboring clubs by invitation. Participating skaters may perform free skate programs, showcase programs, dance patterns, moves in the field elements, or basic skills programs. This event replaces the LSA Fall Invitational Competition that would have taken place on November 7, 2020.

The LSA Fall Celebration 2020 will take place at Iceland Sports Complex, Louisville, KY on October 23, 2020 from approximately 1:00 – 6:00 p.m. A final schedule with detailed times for each performance will be posted shortly after the deadline for registration.

Eligibility and Registration:

Skaters must be members in good standing of USFS. Registration will take place through the Entryeeze system. An email with the registration link will be sent to all prospective participants. All entries will be submitted to the skater's head coach for final approval.

The cost to participate includes:

- Skater's 4- 5 minute group warm up
- A professional video of the skater's performance
- Professional photos of the performance (50 – 100 per skater)
- Free access to live streaming of the entire exhibition, which will be available afterward for 1-2 weeks
- 1 chaperone ticket, giving access to watch the exhibition for approximately one hour around the skater's performance time

Deadline and Refunds:

The deadline to register is October 9, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. Refunds will not be given, except in the event that the skater feels sick, has tested positive for Covid-19, or believes to have been exposed to Covid-19. In any event, fees relating to registration will not be refunded. Registered skaters who must withdraw

for any of these allowable reasons should notify the event chair in writing at hatchpurnell@gmail.com prior to 10:00 a.m. on October 23, 2020 in order to receive the refund.

Music:

Music for all performers must be submitted by email in advance of the event. Music must follow USFS guidelines for the event and level at which the skater is performing. More details on how to submit music will be sent after registration.

Tickets and Live Stream:

Participating skaters will receive one chaperone ticket which will allow access for approximately one hour of the show, including the skater's performance. Additional tickets will be sold on a limited basis and in accordance with LSA Covid restrictions.

The entire exhibition will be live streamed. Participants will receive the link to watch the show in advance. Others who wish to watch the Fall Celebration will be able to purchase access to the link. Both limited in-person tickets and the live stream link will be available for sale through the LSA website.

Critiques:

LSA will arrange for judge/technical critiques for skaters performing well-balanced free skate programs at the pre-juvenile, open juvenile, and juvenile free skate level and higher. These critiques will be conducted via email. The cost for a critique is \$10. Skaters who purchase a critique will be given information on submitting their video, program content, and any questions to the technical specialist and judge arranged for this event.

Practice Ice:

LSA will offer practice ice prior to the start of the LSA Fall Celebration 2020. The cost of practice ice is \$10 for a 20 minute segment. Times will be posted with the final schedule.

Covid Requirements:

Skaters will be asked to wear masks at all times in the rink, except during their actual performance. Masks must be worn during practice ice and warm-ups. Coaches and spectators must wear a mask at all times and must maintain social distancing.
