Event Overview:

The **2021 LSA Spring Skating Festival** is a sanctioned skating exhibition open to skaters of all ages and levels. The exhibition will take place on **Saturday, March 13, 2021** at Iceland Sports Complex, 1701 UPS Dr., Louisville, KY. A professional videographer will be on hand to live stream the event for all to see. A recording of each skaters' performance along with 50-100 action shots per skater will be included in the registration fee.

ELIGIBILITY: The Spring Skating Festival is open to all current members of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or an individual member in accordance with the current U.S. Figure Skating rulebook.

REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEES:

Registration for the Spring Skating Festival will be done through the Merchandise tab on Entryeeze. To find the Merchandise tab, log into your Entryeeze account. [Link to Entryeeze](#)

Out of club skaters wanting to participate should contact the event chair to register.

The deadline to register is **February 21, 2021** at 11:59 PM.

- Free Skate/Short Program/Showcase.....\$85.00 first event
- Basic Skills/Pattern Dance.....\$65.00
- Second Event.....\$40.00

General Event Parameters:

Skaters entering the **Spring Skating Festival**, may choose to skate an Adult, Excel, or Well Balanced Free Skate/Short Program/Solo Dance, Pattern Dance or Showcase with the music time appropriate for their level.

Basic skills skaters may do a Free Skate or Showcase program to music of their choice using full ice, music time should not exceed 1:10.

MUSIC: Music must be submitted by March 5, 2021. Information on where to send music will follow after the close of entries on February 21, 2021.

PRACTICE ICE: LSA will offer practice ice prior to the start of the Spring Skating Festival. Practice ice can be purchased through the Merchandise tab on Entryeeze and will be open until March 10, 2021. The cost of practice is \$10.00 for a 20 minute segment. Spaces will be limited. Times will be posted with the final schedule.

Each skater will be scheduled to a group. The group will have a 5 min. warm up prior to performing their program for video and live streaming.

TICKETS AND LIVE STREAM: A live stream of the event will be available for purchase for \$9.95 via the Merchandise tab on Entryeeze. A registration link that can be sent to friends and family who may want to purchase a virtual ticket will also be available. Each skater will be given a complimentary ticket for 1 chaperone to attend the Skating Festival. Additional spectator tickets to the Spring Skating Festival will be sold in accordance with local and state government guidelines at the time of the event and *may* be available for \$5.00 at the door.

REFUND POLICY: Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entry date unless the event is cancelled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals. The online processing fees are not refundable.

SKATING FESTIVAL COVID POLICIES: If a skater, coach or anyone in their family has tested positive for covid-19, is exhibiting covid symptoms, or is a close contact of a positive case we ask they do not come and refunds for the registration only will be issued.

- Skaters may only enter the facility 15 minutes before their scheduled ice time and must leave within 15 minutes of when they are finished
- Off ice warm up and cool downs must be done outside the facility
- All patrons who enter the facility must wear a mask at all times.
- Skaters may remove their mask for the performance only.
- All patrons who enter the facility must complete a temperature check upon entry
- Skaters are allowed 1 chaperone to enter the facility with them

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES: All coaches participating the **Skating Festival** must meet current U.S. Figure Skating compliance requirements.
